Dear Colts Neck High School Student and Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

I am excited as I enter my fourth year as Principal of Colts Neck High School and I look forward to continuing to work together with all of you and our talented and dedicated staff to build upon prior successes towards an even brighter future.

Parent Portal/Required Documentation

The parent portal (https://parents.frhsd.com/genesis/parents) provides electronic access to forms and important information, including student attendance, grades, and conduct. The portal will be accessible starting Monday, August 15th. If you are in need of assistance logging in to the parent portal, please contact the CNHS guidance office at (732) 761-0190, ext. 1030.

Parents are required to log into their parent account, review the forms and information and acknowledge their review. This acknowledgment will constitute an electronic signature and will have the same force and effect as a written signature. Please log-in, review, and acknowledge through an electronic signature the following important documents:

- 2016-2017 Student-Family Handbook Acknowledgement Form
- Network Use Agreement Form
- FERPA and Directory Notification of Rights Form
- Media Information Release Form
- Student Health History Form Parent Questionnaire
- NJ Family Care Information Form
- Emergency Contact Form (Note: you will be prompted to update your child's emergency contact information in the Parent Portal)

Schedules will available for viewing as of Friday, August 19th at 4:00 pm, but will not be visible until all required forms are reviewed and acknowledged. Please contact the CNHS main office to request paper forms if you do not have computer/internet access. Any questions regarding schedules should be directed to the guidance office. As a reminder, requests for a schedule change will only be considered for the following reasons (and these guidelines and procedures for schedule changes will be followed at all times):

- 1. Data processing errors (i.e. a required course is not on the student schedule or the requested level is not indicated).
- 2. Successful credit recovery program or credit advancement which allows progress to the next sequential course.
- 3. Seniors who require a course to fulfill a graduation requirement.
- 4. A documented history of student/teacher/family conflict. Requests for schedule changes based on teacher preference will not be honored.

In addition, bussing information will be available for you to review. Click on the "View Bus Pass" link in order to download and print the student bus pass. This handbook contains important information that you and your child should review together. Building expectations and protocols will also be reviewed with students in class meetings at the start of the year.

If there is an outstanding fine noted in the parent portal, please settle that with our main office staff as soon as possible. As soon as these requirements are satisfied, a locker will be assigned.

Schedule for Opening Day(s)

For all incoming <u>freshmen</u>, orientation will take place on Tuesday, September 6th, from 8:25 – 10:40. You should report to your bus stop at the time indicated on the bus pass. Upon your arrival, please report directly to the **AUDITORIUM**. Counselors will be on hand in the auditorium to assist students with identifying homeroom locations, where student schedules will be distributed. After an opening address, students will be dismissed to homeroom and follow an abbreviated schedule until dismissal at 10:40. No lunch will be served on this day. Hopefully this will give students a chance, not only to see classroom locations, but also to meet teachers and to become familiar with the building prior to the first day of school.

<u>ALL</u> students will report for a 'regular' day on Wednesday, September 7th. Homeroom begins at 8:25. **Students are expected to bring a hard copy of their schedule**.

Attendance - "Every Day Counts"

Consistent daily attendance and on time arrival to school is critical to the learning process and academic success. In accordance with State law, students are required to attend school regularly to ensure continuity of instruction and classroom participation. Your child's course credit may be withdrawn if the total number of absences (excused and unexcused) is excessive, which is defined as exceeding:

five (5) days for a quarter course
nine (9) days for a half year course
fourteen (14) days for a three-quarter course
eighteen (18) days for a full-year course

Attendance shall be taken daily in every class and parent/guardians will be notified of absences through various communications. Interventions and supports will be provided to students to assist in improving attendance.

Safety/Security

The safety and security of all of our students and staff is a top priority. As part of that effort, designated entrance doors will open at 7:45 am and all doors will be secured at 8:30 am. After 8:30 am, all visitors will be required to be buzzed in through our main entrance, and required to show identification and sign in with our security officers. Parents/Guardians dropping off items for their child will be asked to leave the items in the designated location and immediately exit the building. We thank you in advance for your understanding and cooperation.

All morning drop offs will be at the main entrance on the 537 side of the building. **There will be no morning drop offs permitted on the Five Points Road side of the building**.
