Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

Welcome to another season of Freehold High School Fall Athletics! The athletes have been putting in a lot of practice time to get ready for their fall season. To comply with the regulations set forth for outdoor activities, we have made the following adjustments to protocols for attending our sporting events.

Please be aware of the following for ALL SPORTING EVENTS:

- All pre- and post-game handshaking protocols have been suspended for all sports.
- Spectators should arrive no earlier than 30 minutes prior to game time and are expected to exit the premises immediately following the event.
- **Spectators are NOT permitted to attend FRHSD scrimmages in any sport.**
- **ALL spectators will be required to wear face coverings at ALL times and adhere to the six (6) foot social distancing protocols for ALL SPORTING EVENTS, as guided by the NJDOH, NJSIAA and CDC.**

CROSS COUNTRY / FIELD HOCKEY / SOCCER / TENNIS:

- Spectators must bring their own chairs.
- Only families of the participants will be permitted to attend. **STUDENT sections WILL NOT** be permitted.
- Students who have a sibling participating will be allowed to attend with their family.

FOOTBALL ONLY:

- Tickets will be required for entry and are for families of the participants only.
- Each participant (football, band and cheerleaders) will receive two tickets the day **before** the game.
- **No additional tickets will be sold at the gate. STUDENT sections WILL NOT** be permitted.
- Students who have a sibling participating will only be permitted to attend by using one of the two family tickets given. **Extra sibling tickets will NOT be issued.**
- Spectators must sit in the bleachers and ensure social distancing.
- Crowd capacity is 500 people. The visiting team will be guaranteed 100 tickets.
- The visiting team's band, dance team, or cheerleaders **WILL NOT** attend football games.
- Our band, dance team and cheerleaders will only attend home football games.
- No one is permitted inside the building for any reason. Port-A-Johns will be available for public use.
- Teams will have their pre-game and half-time at a specified location close to the fields.
- The Snack Shack **WILL NOT** be open.

We ask that all of these protocols be followed. Failure to comply will result in immediate dismissal from the property and possible suspension or cancellation of the event. If you have any questions or concerns about these new protocols, please do not hesitate to contact me.
