2023-2024 Chromebook Rules and Guidelines Agreement Form**

As our students' embark on their educational and post-secondary journeys, technology continues to evolve as a critical and necessary tool for enhancing learning and collaborative opportunities. FRHSD will ensure that every student has access to a Chromebook that will enable them to participate in opportunities, learning experiences, and collaborative processes in and out of school so they are prepared for their post-secondary aspirations.

Each student will have access to their own personal Chromebook for learning in school and at home. Students will be able to access Google Apps for Education where they can participate in course activities in an electronically collaborative environment.

Parents/guardians are required to submit a **ONE time usage fee of \$50 per student** which provides the student with a Chromebook and support. Students who submit a Chromebook for repair *more than one time during the duration of their tenure* in school will be charged the cost of the replacement part. Cost of the replacement part will be determined at the time of repair. If the Chromebook is determined to be *broken beyond repair*, the student will be responsible for the replacement cost of the Chromebook.

If the Chromebook is lost or stolen, the student will immediately notify the school administration. The School shall not be responsible for any damages or losses related to the Chromebook. Any costs associated with instances of loss, theft or damage will be the full responsibility of the student and their parent/guardian. The replacement cost of the Chromebook is due within two (2) weeks of reporting the unit lost, stolen or damaged beyond repair.

In order to maintain the privilege of using the school-issued Chromebook, I agree to the following:

Keep the Chromebook in my possession at all times. I will not give or lend it to anyone except to return it to the school for repair in case it is damaged. If placed in a locker, the lock will be set and the combination will not be shared with anyone else. During Physical Education class, it is to be secured in a locked locker. The Chromebook must be carried in a secure manner to minimize the chances that it will be damaged or destroyed. The Chromebook must remain in the district provided protective case at all times. I will bring my Chromebook to school fully charged.

Follow Policy 7523 - School District Provided Technology Chromebooks to Students, and will not use the Chromebook, in or out of school, for inappropriate or unlawful purposes. I understand that the school will fully cooperate with all relevant authorities in investigating and prosecuting any unlawful use.

The Chromebook must be returned to the Freehold Regional High School District if I leave the district, for any reason, before the end of my senior year. I further understand any applications, music, etc., loaded on the Chromebook become the property of the school district and will not be returned.

Please acknowledge that you have reviewed and understand the following:

The Chromebook is an essential part of the student's education and that they will need to have the Chromebook fully charged, in working condition for the start of each day.

The Chromebook may record or collect information on my use if the Chromebook is equipped with a camera, global positioning system, or other feature capable of recording or collecting information on my activity or use of the Chromebook. It is possible this collection of information on the student's activity or use of the Chromebook may occur outside of the school.

The School District shall not use any of the capabilities in a manner that would violate the privacy rights of the student or any individual residing with the student as per N.J.S.A.18A:3639 (P.L. 2013, c. 44).

The Chromebook comes with filtering software. While in school and at home, Chromebooks will use the Wi-Fi to access the Internet. Wi-Fi access outside of school must be provided by the parent/guardian.

As the parent/guardian, I am responsible for monitoring my student's use of the Internet at home. I am responsible for deciding how, when, and where the Chromebook is used by my student outside of school based on their educational needs.

If the Chromebook is lost or stolen, I will immediately notify the school administration. I understand that the School shall not be responsible for any damages or losses related to the Chromebook. Any costs associated with instances of loss, theft or damage will be the full responsibility of the student's parent/guardian.

I am responsible for the replacement cost of the Chromebook should it get broken beyond repair, stolen or lost at a cost of **\$300**.

I am responsible for the replacement cost of the Chromebook screen should it get broken, at a cost of **\$50**.

I am responsible for the replacement cost of the Chromebook charger should it get broken, stolen or lost at a cost of **\$25**.

Failure to comply with any of these rules and policies may result in disciplinary action including the suspension of my use of the Chromebook.
