Spectator Bus Rules & Permission Slip for Boys Basketball Group 4 Championship Game on 3/13/22

FORMS MUST be turned in to Mr. Ryden during Unit Lunch in the MIDDLE GYM on Friday, 3/11/22 to be eligible for the Spectator Bus.

NOT all students that hand in a permission slip are guaranteed a spot on the bus as seating is limited, seats on the bus will be granted on a first-come, first-serve basis. Seating is limited to 50 students.

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Your child has signed up to ride the spectator bus to watch our Boys Varsity Basketball team participate in the Group 4 Championship Game against Elizabeth High School at Rutgers University on Sunday, March 13, 2022. All students who would like to ride the Spectator Bus must report to the doors outside the Gym by 10:00am on Sunday, March 13, 2022. The bus should return to Marlboro High School at approximately 2:30pm. Students will be instructed to notify their parents/guardians upon their departure from Rutgers University so there are no delays in student pick-up from Marlboro High School. Please review the Spectator Bus rules below with your child. All permission slips must be returned to Mr Ryden during Unit lunch in the middle gym on Friday, March 11, 2022- **no exceptions!** Students won't be allowed on the bus without signing up.

- 1) ***Students riding the spectator bus MUST return on the same spectator bus...NO EXCEPTIONS.***
- 2) ***Students must follow all school rules as per the FRHSD Student-Family Handbook. Students may be subject to a breathalyzer.***
- 3) ***Seating on the bus will be assigned by the chaperones- students must abide by all instructions.***
- 4) ***Students may not leave Rutgers University at any time and must return to MHS on the bus.***
- 5) ***Appropriate behavior is expected at all times on the bus and throughout the game.***
- 6) ***Students will not be permitted inside MHS at any point, before or after boarding the bus.***
- 7) ***Students will be responsible for their own admission fees and food/beverage purchases.***
- 8) ***Due to the RU Covid-19 Protocols,(listed below), a copy of your vaccine card or Negative PCR test must be shown to board the bus – NO EXCEPTIONS***

RUTGERS ATHLETICS COVID-19 IN-VENUE PROTOCOLS

Rutgers Athletics is thrilled to welcome the Scarlet Knight faithful back to its campus venues. As we continue to monitor the coronavirus and emerging variants, please check [Scarletknights.com](https://scarletknights.com) for updates regarding COVID-19 venue policies.

- Proof of full vaccination* or proof of a negative COVID-19 PCR test within 72 hours of the event will be required for entry to all indoor events (for all individuals above the age of five).

- Verification of vaccination or negative test result must be accompanied by a valid ID.
- Face masks will be required within all indoor spaces, including Jersey Mike's Arena and the Provident Bank Stadium Club and press box at SHI Stadium. Spectators who fail to comply with the face mask policy will be asked to leave the arena.
- Those occupying indoor spaces may temporarily remove their masks while eating or drinking.
- Guests in outdoor seating locations are not required to wear a mask.
