Our school system is committed to protecting student, teacher and staff health. To protect our community and be in compliance with the Department of Education regulations, the Freehold Regional High School District tested our schools' drinking water for lead.

### Results of our Testing

Following instructions given in technical guidance developed by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, we identified and tested all drinking water and food preparation outlets. Of the three samples taken, all tested below the lead action level established by the United States Environmental Protection Agency for lead in drinking water (15 µg/l [ppb]).
