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The Board of Education is committed to providing a high quality educational program, virtually or remotely, in the event a school or the schools of the district are required to close for more than three consecutive school days due to a declared state of emergency, declared public health emergency, or a directive by the appropriate health agency or officer to institute a public health-related closure. The district's virtual or remote program of instruction shall be in accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:7F-9.

In the event the school district is required to close a school or the schools of the district for more than three consecutive school days due to a declared state of emergency, declared public health emergency, or a directive by the appropriate health agency or officer to institute a public health-related closure, the Commissioner of Education shall allow the district to apply to the 180-day requirement established pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7F-9, one or more days of virtual or remote instruction provided to students on the day or days the schools of the district were closed if the program of virtual or remote instruction meets such criteria as may be established by the Commissioner Education.

A day of virtual or remote instruction, if instituted under the district's Commissioner of Education's approved program of virtual or remote instruction, shall be considered the equivalent of a full day of school attendance for the purposes of meeting State and local graduation requirements, the awarding of course credit, and other such matters as determined by the Commissioner of Education.

The Freehold Regional High School District is continuing to consult with state and local officials from the New Jersey Department of Health and the New Jersey Department of Education regarding the coronavirus (COVID-19) and its impact on student education.

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### Board Approval of the Remote Instruction Program Plan

- On October 14, 2021, Freehold Regional High School District Board of Education approved the Freehold Regional High School District's Remote Instruction Program Plan for school closure based upon P.L.2020c.27 in the event of a public health-related closure. The 2021-2022 Remote Instruction program Plan for School Closure meets the requirements of N.J.S.A. 18A:7F-9(c) and was submitted to the Department of Education.
- The Remote Instruction Program Plan is posted on the District's website.

### Continued Operations during In-Person School Closure

#### Hours of Instruction

- The Remote Instruction Program will be facilitated following a regular school day schedule.

#### Food Service

- Our Food Service Management Company (Pomptonian) will provide for the issuance of meals to eligible students with prepackaged, shelf-stable meals for students. Freehold Boro High School is also available for meal pick-up on Mondays and Thursdays between 5:00pm and 7:00pm.

#### Facilities

- The facilities are being maintained during the closure as per guidance issued by the CDC. Preparation for reopening, as well as maintaining safe facilities when students and staff return will also be guided in accordance with CDC standards including, but not limited to the following: [Guidance for Cleaning and Disinfecting](#).

#### Technology

- All students are issued Chromebooks and are given support with access to Wifi, as needed.
- Staff members have a district-issued laptop and charging device.
- Professional learning and support was provided for all FRHSD teachers to engage students in assignments and assessment in Google Classroom and Google Meet.

#### Remote Instruction

- All students will attend their scheduled classes synchronously via Google Meet and Google Classroom.
- The district attendance policy will be in effect. Attendance will be submitted in Genesis within the first 10 minutes of class.
- Students attend classes via Google Meet and must have their camera on and microphone muted. Teachers may ask students to unmute when appropriate to do so.
- Students will communicate with their teachers with their FRHSD email and Google Classrooms for their courses.
- Students will complete class assignments as provided by the teacher within established deadlines.
- The FRHSD Grading System and Genesis will be used to measure and communicate student progress and to determine marking period and final grades.
- Staff members will continue routine parent communications using FRHSD email and Genesis.

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### Provisions for Addressing the Needs of English Language Learners

- Announcements and notifications posted to the District website will be translated to the native language.
- Teachers will use Google Meets to monitor the students' speaking, writing, listening, and reading skills.

### Provisions for Appropriate Special Education and Related Services for Students with Disabilities

- Educational resources will be modified and accommodated to meet the needs of all students, as appropriate.
- Student accommodations and modifications will be implemented in accordance with IEPs to the greatest extent practicable.
- Staff members will facilitate related services for students through Google Classroom and Google Meet, as appropriate, to the greatest extent practicable.
- Out of District students will access remote instruction as provided by their placement and in accordance with their IEPs.
- IEP meetings will be held via Google Meet or phone conference, upon parental preference. Evaluations and reevaluations that are able to be conducted virtually will be administered.

### Counseling Services Available to Students

- Staff members will monitor email during the regularly scheduled school day to assist students and families.
- Students will have access to community mental health services as needed via [FRHSD.com](http://FRHSD.com).
