
New Jersey's Administrative Code (N.J.A.C. 6A-15-1.6) requires that school districts, "providing a bilingual program, ESL program, or English language services shall submit a plan every three years to the Department of Education for approval." The New Jersey Department of Education's Office of Supplemental Educational Programs has reviewed and **approved** your district's 2017-2020 Bilingual/ESL/ELS Three-Year Plan submitted pursuant to this requirement.

The NJDOE may monitor the implementation of the district's Bilingual/ESL/ELS Three-Year Plan. Therefore, during this three-year period, the district must inform the NJDOE of any modifications to its services for English language learners by emailing ell@doe.nj.gov.
