Dear Parent/Guardian:

As per the New Jersey Department of Health (NJDOH), Monmouth County is now considered to be in the [“high activity level”](#) for COVID-19. As a result of this NJDOH designation, the Freehold Regional High School District will be required to contact trace and [quarantine](#) any person who may have been deemed a **close contact to someone who was exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19**. Prior to this designation, the Freehold Regional High School District was only required to contact trace and quarantine individuals who were deemed a close contact to a person who was confirmed to test positive for COVID-19.

In accordance with the New Jersey Department of Health, “close contact” is defined as someone who was within 6 feet of an infected or symptomatic person for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period starting from 2 days before illness onset (or, for asymptomatic patients, 2 days prior to test specimen collection) until the time the patient is isolated.)
