A Few Notes of Importance

- Student attendance must continue to be a matter of importance to students, their families, our staff, and the administration. As a reminder, course credit will be withdrawn if a student's total number of absences (excused and unexcused/unexplained) is excessive. Excessive is defined as exceeding four (4) days for a quarter year course, seven (7) days for a semester course, twelve (12) days for a three-quarter year course, and fourteen (14) days for a full-year course.
