Student Eligibility Requirements

Students must meet the following requirements to be eligible to participate. Participation of ineligible students shall result in individual and team sanctions.

1. Students must be passing all of their classes.
2. Students must attend all of their scheduled classes in order to participate in a practice or contest on that day.
3. In addition to other infractions, a student may be suspended or removed from the event for unexcused absences or chronic tardiness to classes or practices or discipline.
4. A student may not participate when he/she is serving an in-school or out-of-school suspension.
5. Students must satisfy school and school system participation standards.

Participation Standards

At a minimum, the following standards are required of all participants.

1. Exhibit public behavior that will reflect positively on the fellow competitors, school, and community.
2. Exhibit responsible, respectful, and trustworthy behavior to fellow competitors and the advisor(s).
3. Exert efforts to maintain a high level of academic achievement.
4. Comply with the fellow competitors, school, and school system rules, regulations, and policies.
5. Exhibit appropriate behavior towards the fellow competitors and all school-related activities.
6. Respect and comply with decisions made by the advisor or administration.
7. Display good sportsmanship at all times.

Rules, Policies and Procedures

Students participating in a Senior Event must be in good standing academically. Students must have good attendance and behavior.

There will be nothing inappropriate or offensive; vulgarity, sexual innuendos, etc. You must come fully prepared to dress rehearsal with every costume and prop you plan to have. Anything done the evening of MR. CNHS that is not approved in advance by administration will result in an automatic disqualification and termination from the event, and may result in administrative disciplinary actions.
