R 9190 DISTRICT - COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS

The Superintendent:

1. Provides oversight for the institutionalization of district and community partnerships through the necessary leadership and infrastructure that will maintain momentum and progress including ongoing advocacy and capacity building, systems for quality assurance and regular data reporting, ongoing evaluation, and celebration of partnership accomplishments.
2. Directs creation and maintenance of an online database of district and community partnerships to be housed on the district web site,
3. Directs compliance with uniform protocol for approval of district and community partnerships that impact the instructional program and/or district operations as set forth:
 - a) Initial contact with a prospective community partner will occur through an online contact form housed on the district web site, www.frhsd.com.
 - b) A central administrator will review the request for partnership and route the request to the appropriate school principal or district department office to evaluate the proposal against the overall district mission and curricular, co-curricular, and extra-curricular goals.
 - c) The school principal or district department office supervisor will recommend to the Superintendent through formal report to approve or decline a prospective partnership as it relates to the district mission and specific curricular goals.
 - d) A central office administrator will inform the prospective partner in writing of the decision of the school district.
 - e) Annually, in the month of October, a formal review of current district and community partnerships will occur through collaboration of central office personnel and school principals. As a result, modifications may be made to the partnership in consultation with the community partner.
 - f) Celebration of district and community partnership accomplishments shall occur, as merited. An annual letter of thanks and appreciation shall be sent by the school
